


Clarification w.r.t. Part IV of CEA Regulations- applicability

This has reference to the Part IV of the CEA (Technical Standards for Connectivity to the Grid) Regulations, 2007. It is clarified that:

- (i) The condition of voltage and current harmonic as prescribed under Part IV is applicable only to the consumers which are defined as bulk consumers and drawing power at 33KV and above.
- (ii) For the purpose of bulk consumer means a consumer who avails supply at voltage of 33 KV or above.

Therefore, Part IV of CEA Regulations is applicable only to consumers drawing power at 33 KV or above and any consumer who is drawing power below 33 KV shall not be covered under Part IV of CEA (Technical Standards for Connectivity of the Grid) Regulations, 2007.
