Prior approval of Government of India under section 68 of the Electricity Act 2003 for 'Transmission system for Ultra Mega Solar Park (750 MWs) in Rewa district, Madya Pradesh"

Reference: C/CP/MoP/Solar Park - Rewa dated 10.09.2015

This has reference to PGCIL letter dated 10.09.2015, requesting for prior Sir. approval of Government under section 68 (1) of Electricity Act, 2003 in favour of M/s PGCIL for implementation of the scheme "Transmission system for Ultra Mega Solar Park (750 MWs) in Rewa district, Madhya Pradesh" with following scope of works:

(i) Establishment of 400/220kV, 3 X 500 MVA Pooling Station at Rewa

(ii) LILO of Vindhyachal – Jabalpur 400kV 2nd D/c line (circuit-3&4) at Rewa Pooling Station

(iii) 400 kV, 1 X 125 MVAr bus reactor at Rewa Pooling Station

- (iv) 6 no. of 220kV line bays at Rewa Pooling station (for its interconnection with solar park)
- The scope of works mentioned above, have been agreed in 38th Standing Committee Meeting (SCM) on power system planning of Western Region 2. held on 17.07.2015 at New Delhi.
- CEA conveys the prior approval of Government under Section 68(1) of Electricity Act, 2003 for the scheme 'Transmission system for Ultra Mega Solar 3. Park (750 MWs) in Rewa district, Madhya Pradesh' with above scope of works to M/s PGCIL.
- This approval is subject to compliance of
 - The requirement of the relevant provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003, as amended from time to time and the rules and regulations framed thereunder and
 - CEA's (Measures relating to Safety and Electrical Supply) Regulations, 2010 framed under the Electricity Act, 2003.

- The approval is also subject to the following conditions:
 - The implementing agency will commence construction of the project within three years, unless this term is extended by the Central Electricity Authority.
 - ii) Central Electricity Authority may withdraw the approval before the expiry of the period of three years after giving a one month notice.
 - iii) The implementing agencies shall abide by the provisions of Works of Licensee Rules, 2006 notified by the Government of India, Ministry of Power in the Gazette of India, extra-ordinary Part-II, Section 3(i) dated 18-04-2006 (vide GSR 217 (E) dated 18-04-2006).

Provided that 'nothing contained in this rule shall effect the powers conferred upon any licensee under section 164 of the Electricity Act 2003'.
