Subject: Second Meeting of the Technical Committee constituted by CEA for study of optimal location of various types of balancing energy sources/energy storage devices to facilitate grid integration of Renewable Energy Sources (RES) and associated issues to be held in Chennai on 09-05-2017. - reg.

महोदय/Sir,

CEA had vide Order No. CEA/Plg/RES-30/2017 dated 30th January, 2017 (Copy enclosed for ready reference) constituted a Technical Committee under the chairmanship of Member (Planning), CEA, for study of optimal location of the various types of balancing energy sources /energy storage devices to facilitate grid integration of Renewable Energy Sources (RES) and associated issues. The First meeting of the Committee was held on 23rd February, 2017 at CEA, New Delhi, followed by a meeting of the Sub-group for the Southern Region on 24th March, 2017 at SRPC, Bengaluru.

The Second Meeting of the Technical Committee, specifically concerning the States of Southern Region will be held on 9th May, 2017 (Tuesday) at 10.30 A.M. at TNEB Head Quarters, Howard Hall, First Floor, Chennai (address 800 Annasalai, Chennai -260002).

The Proposed Agenda Items are as under:

- The constituents of Southern Region to the Committee may make a presentation (i) on adverse effects of variability of Wind and Solar generation and how they tackle the same at present. They may also give an assessment of loss of generation and of revenue, because of backing down of cheaper sources of conventional generation and losses due to Deviation Settlement Mechanism, purely on account of variability of renewable generation. Month wise data for 2016-17 and details may be given to support the same.
- Whether any constraints on transmission or distribution (T&D) system have been (ii) faced? If so, necessary augmentation of T&D infrastructure which needs to be undertaken - scope and financial estimates for the same, if any, may be given.
- To propose utilization of State's own balancing plants. (iii)

(iv) An assessment of the quantum of electric storage system for balancing, which could be placed near the RE generation sources.

(v) Details of issues in the Grid Integration of Renewables in Southern Region and the possible solutions, including the suggestions of the Sub-group, as mentioned during its First meeting.

(vi) Status of communication system for RE generators to SLDCs and data received

through the same.

(vii) Any other item with the permission of the Chair.

It is requested that the nominated members of the Committee may please make it convenient to attend the above meeting. It is further requested that the concerned States from the Southern Region may list out the issues for deliberation in the said Meeting and e-mail the same to the Nodal Officer mentioned below, with a copy to undersigned so that the same can be circulated before the meeting for a comprehensive discussion.

OFFICE ORDER

Subject: Constitution of a Technical Committee for study of optimal location of the various types of balancing energy sources /energy storage devices to facilitate grid integration of Renewable Energy Sources and associated issues – reg.

Pursuant to the deliberations held in the Ministry of Power (MoP), it has been decided that Central Electricity Authority (CEA) would undertake a Study for identifying optimal locations for balancing energy sources /energy storage in the country, to facilitate grid integration of renewables, keeping in view the impact of variability of renewable generation on system operation and the ongoing plan for massive capacity addition of renewables.

2. Accordingly, the Central Electricity Authority (CEA) hereby constitutes a Technical Committee with the following composition:

- 3. The Terms of Reference of the Technical Committeewill be as under:
 - i) To identify optimal locations with respect to pooling stations for balancing energy sources /energy storage in the country for facilitating grid integration of Renewable Sources, considering cost benefit analysis;
 - To consider the availability ofstorage/pondage hydro power stations including ii) pumped storage generating stations and existing gas based power plants of neighbouring areas/countries as balancing resource; and,
 - Any other issues incidental thereto. iii)
- The Committee may co-opt any other member, as deemed fit. The Committee shall submit its Report within six(6) months of the receipt of nominations of Members from the respective organizations.
