Consideration of the Certification programme of Power Sector Skill Council by Authority under Central Electricity Safety Regulation, 2010.

Sir,

M/s BSES Rajdhani Power Limited vide their letter dated 31.05.2017 on the above subject has indicated that they have lot of contractual staff working in the field, who are experienced in performing the task. The experience has been acquired by them by doing this kind of work for

many years. However, as per Central Electricity Authority Safety Regulation 2010 under Regulation (3) and sub-regulation (i) designated persons who operate and carry out works on electrical lines and apparatus shall possess certificate of competency or electrical work permit issued by the appropriate Government. In this regard it is stated that in NCR of Delhi, the relevant Certificate of Competency Class II for technical works on electrical line is issued by the State Labour Authorities to ITI passed candidates straightaway and experienced persons without ITI qualification after qualifying exam conducted from time to time by the State Labour Authority.

M/s BSES has indicated that as the State Labour Authorities have not conducted this exam for the last many years and as such, BSES could not induct their contractual staff in their regular work force as it contravenes CEA Safety Regulation, 2010. BSES has further indicated that since these people have been working with them since long time and has acquired adequate expertise so out rightly disqualifying them on the ground that they are not designated persons and without giving them an opportunity to get themselves qualified through exams could create huge uproar as well as law and order problem for BSES at this stage.

Considering the present scenario, M/s BSES has suggested that the technical knowledge and skill of the contractual work force may be upgraded through Power Sector Skill Council (PSSC) under Skill India Mission. It has been intimated that PSSC have developed short-term course for various jobs and rules for technicians for power utilities. These are very structured and relevant to power distribution. The short term course, under Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) considers the vast working experience of the learner and is designed in such a way to cover the job and practical knowledge.

In this regard it is pertinent to mention that under Regulation 29 of CEA Safety Regulation, 2010 there is a provision that the State Government may, by way of Notification, exempt such condition. Since PSSC is a Government of India initiative to upskill or reskill the manpower in certain trade and as the State Labour Authorities, which has the responsibility to provide the Competency Certificate, has not conducted the examination for long period so the proposal of M/s BSES may be considered as an option to legitimize the contractual workers working for long

period in an organization without having proper facilities and job securities enjoyed by the regular worker.

To discuss the above issues, a meeting is being convened on 30th August, 2017 at 11.30 AM in Room No. 311, 3rd Floor, NRPC Building, Katwaria Sarai, New Delhi 110 016. You are requested to make it convenient to attend the meeting.
