Minutes of the 2nd meeting on Awareness Generation Programme on Electrical Safety held on 28th Demcember, 2018 at 11.00 AM in the Conference room of IEEMA at Rishyamook Building, Panchkuian Road, New Delhi.

The 2nd meeting on Awareness Generation Programme on Electrical Safety was held in the Conference room of IEEMA at Rishyamook Building, Panchkuian Road, New Delhi at 11.00 AM on 28.12.2018 to discuss regarding the Awareness Generation Programme on Electrical Safety to be organized in various cities across India. The list of participants in the meeting is enclosed at **Annexure-A**.

2. At the outset, Chief Electrical Inspector (CEI), CEA welcomed all the participants to the meeting. The meeting started with formal introduction of participants.

CEI, CEA stated that the 1st meeting on this subject was held on 03.12.2018 where discussions were held on the broad details of this awareness generation program. This meeting has been convened to deliberate over the Day Schedule and arrangements of the program and its approximate expenditure. He discussed the draft Day Schedule of the one-day awareness generation program which is enclosed at **Annexure-B**.

- 3. He further stated that the cost estimate for conducting a one-day program in city like Delhi has been estimated and it is coming out to be around 2.5 Lakh Rupees for making arrangements in a hotel. The details of the cost estimate for conducting a one-day program is given at **Annexure-C**. This expenditure includes venue, hall equipment, high tea (twice), lunch, vehicle, pamphlets, and stationary. He stated that the cost of conducting this one-day program can be reduced, if we can get the meeting hall of PSUs or State government facilities. However, our priority would be to get these meeting halls in the PSU/State Government facilities. If no such meeting hall could be arranged, only then the facilities in the hotel will be looked for and that too not above 3-star standard.
- 4. He further requested the participants for their suggestions/views on these proposals. The participants gave the

following suggestions for inclusion in the awareness generation program: -

- i. Display of proper PPE equipment and standard switches and wires.
- ii. The program should cover the information like whom to contact in case of electrical accident.
- iii. Case studies of electrical accidents occurred in that particular area.
- iv. Playing videos over electrical accident in the program.
- v. Creating a WhatsApp Group for circulating information and videos related to electrical accidents.
- vi. Media shall be invited for coverage of the event for wider propagation of the message of the program.
- vii. Most of the participants suggested to start our program with North-Eastern States.
- 5. CEI, CEA appreciated all the suggestions and assured the members to consider these suggestions in the program. He stated that for item (i), stalls would be arranged at the program site. Accordingly, talks are on with IEEMA. The items (ii) to (iv) would be covered in the course of the program. Item (v) and (vi) would be taken care by CEI Division of CEA. Item (vii) was agreed by all.
- 6. CEI, CEA stated that in the last meeting it was requested that the participants may discuss the issue regarding owning some of workshops in a year. A letter in this respect was also sent to all the CMDs of the PSUs to own some of the workshops in a year. So, that continuity of this program can be maintained and the awareness generation exercise could be carried out seamlessly throughout India. He requested the participants to intimate the views of their organization in this regard.

Representative from IOCL confirmed that IOCL is ready to own two programs one in Ranchi, Jharkhand and one in Salawas, Rajasthan.

CEI, CEA informed that ONGC has confirmed its willingness to own programs in North-East. He requested all the participants to own the events as much as they can and intimate the same **at least by first week of January**. He further requested to nominate the nodal officers for their organizations at the earliest.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
