Minutes of Meeting taken by Member (PS), CEA at New Delhi on 4th Dec 2017 to review the progress of Mahan – Sipat 400 KV D/C transmission line being executed by Essar Power Transmission Company Ltd. (EPTCL)

List of participants is enclosed at Annexure - I.

- 2. Member (PS) welcomed all the participants and expressed his concern on slow progress of Mahan- Sipat 400 kV transmission line and advised M/s EPTCL and M/s KPTL to expedite its progress in view of the criticality of evacuation of power from Mahan TPS. He requested Chief Engineer (PSPM) to take up the agenda of the meeting.
- 3. Representative of M/s EPTCL(Essar Power) submitted current status of progress of the line as under;

Total locations 942 nos
Total length 337 km

Foundations completed 942 nos

• Tower erection 924 nos.(work u/p at locs.)

• Stringing completed 257 km

and stated that additional manpower resources would be required to complete line by Dec, 17/Jan, 17.

- 4. Representative of M/s KPTL (Katpataru Power) submitted the status of manpower deployed at site as under;
 - a. Tower Erection:
 - Presently 3 Tower Erection gangs are working.
 - b. Stringing
 - Presently; 4 TSE & 2 Manual stringing gangs are deployed by KPTL Further, two teams are working for Restoration works / crossings.

and expressed their concern on unavailability of front for carrying out tower erection and stringing works.

- 5. EPTCL confirmed that following shall be ensured on ongoing basis, for ensuring clear work front to achieve targeted output:
 - (i) All outstanding bills have been cleared by EPTCL.
 - (ii) EPTCL has contacted the district collectors of Balrampur & Surajpur of Chhattisgarh and Singrauli district of M.P. as well as SPs and SDMs. EPTCL is in regular interaction with local Tehsildars & Patwaris. We are making on spot payments by cheques for compensation to farmers for Tower erections &

- (iii) EPTCL has lined up security persons / police protection wherever required.
- (iv) EPTCL Engineers are available at each working locations and proactively resolving all RoW issues for which we have deployed our entire coordination resources.
- (v) EPTCL shall ensure reimbursement payment of all past and future ROW payments/Crop compensation payments on actual payment basis.
- 6. Further EPTCL informed that there is short tower material at site which needs to be expedited.
 - a) Tower Extension of loc. 68F (QD+9)
 - b) Tower Extension of loc. 68C (QD+3),
 - c) Tower Extension of loc. 5B (QB+9),
 - d) Tower Extension of loc. 2D (QC+6),
 - e) Strengthened cross-arms of Loc. 86-87

KPTL informed all the above materials have been despatched for site on 01st Dec 2017 and reach site by 7th Dec 2017.

7. In order to complete balance work and deployment of additional manpower, KPTL agreed to augment manpower and complete balance work as under;

a. Balance 18 nos. Tower erection

- KPTL have agreed to deploy these 3 Tower Erection gangs as follows:
 - 1st and 2nd Gang shall reach at site on 05th Dec 2017, manpower has already reached Renukoot.
 - ii. 3rd gang is expected to reach by 10th Dec 2017.
- KPTL confirmed that with above additional mobilization, the tower erection shall be completed by 31st Dec 2017.

b. Balance stringing sections aggregating to 80 km

- The 5th TSE is available on field. Associated T&P will reach site by mid of Dec 2017 and the same will be made operational by 15th Dec 2017.
- Additional 3 (Three) Manual stringing gangs are required to be deployed urgently for starting work at (i) Loc. AP 42, (ii) at Loc. AP 23 and from Power Plant Gantry at loc. 0/1. However, KPTL will review this additional requirement of manual stringing gangs and will revert by 15th Dec 2017.
- KPTL confirmed that with above additional mobilization, the stringing laying shall be completed on best efforts by end of Jan 2018.

Meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.
