Subject: Decommissioning of Unit-1 to 5 (3x95MW & 2x210MW) of Badarpur Thermal Power Station of NTPC Ltd. regarding.

Sir,

This is with reference to your above email regarding removal of Badarpur Plant capacity (3x95MW & 2x210MW) from the Monitored Installed Capacity of NTPC Ltd. The details furnished by NTPC Ltd. have been seen by the Central Electricity Authority.

As per the Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) of Environment Pollution (Prevention & Control) Authority (EPCA) and on expiry of validity of consent to operate order issued by Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC) dated 25.07.2018, the operation of Badarpur Thermal Power Station (3x95MW+ 2x210MW) has been closed down permanently as the last unit (Unit No. 5) has been stopped at 20:30 hrs on 15th October, 2018.

It is seen from the minutes of 465th meeting of Board of Directors, NTPC held on 13th October, 2018 that the approval for permanent stoppage of operation & decommissioning of Unit 1 to 5 of Badarpur TPS (3x95 MW & 2x210MW) has been accorded.

Since, the NTPC Ltd. has removed the installed capacity of Unit-1 to5 (3x95MW & 2x210MW) Badarpur TPS from its total Monitored Installed Capacity of NTPC Ltd., the capacity of these units are being deleted from the data base of All India Installed Capacity of CEA records.
