Subject:- Replacement of Old & inefficient thermal units by supercritical units-Decommissioning & retirement of Mahagenco's 200 MW Unit 5 of Koradi TPS.

Sir.

This is with reference to your above referred letter dated 03.04.2017 regarding intimation for decommissioning & Retirement of unit-5 with installed capacity of 200 MW at Koradi Thermal Power Station as per the decision of MAHAGENCO's Board of Directors, along with the copy of the Board resolution dated 15.03.2017 on the same. It is seen that decision to retire this unit has been taken by Board of MAHAGENCO's in its meeting held on 02.03.2017. After deliberation, the Board accorded approval to decommission and retire 200 MW Unit 5 of Koradi TPS from service from the date of approval by the Board i.e. 02.03.2017.

It has already been decided by the Central Electricity Authority (CEA) that it is not mandatory for the generating company to seek approval of the CEA for retirement of their units, which may take its own decision, based on techno-economic reasons as deemed appropriate by it, in the matter. An intimation to that effect was sent to all utilities vide letter dated 25.01.2017. A copy of the same is enclosed for ready reference.

The decision to retire unit no. 5 of Koradi, TPS has been taken by MAHAGENCO, based on their own techno-economic reasons and based on their decision, the unit is being deleted from our records of Installed Capacity.
