**Subject:** Approval of the Designated Authority (DA) to NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Limited for participation in Cross Border Trade of Electricity (CBTE) for export of 300 MW of power to Bangladesh Power Development Board (BPDB)- regarding

महोदय/ Sir,


This has reference to the application of NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam (NVVN) Limited received vide your letter no. NVVN/BD/Cross Border/H14 dated 24.05.2018 seeking approval of the Designated Authority (DA) for participation in CBTE for export of 300MW of power to Bangladesh Power Development Board (BPDB) under short term as well as in long term.

1. The proposal of NVVN, as participating entity, for export of 300MW of power to BPDB has been examined and is found to be in order. The communication from MEA in this regard is awaited.
2. Accordingly, the Designated Authority conveys its approval to NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Limited, as participating entity, as per the Guidelines on CBTE issued by MoP in December 2016, for participation in CBTE for export of 300MW of power to BPDB under short term (from June 2018 to December 2019) as well as long term (from January 2020 to May 2033).
3. This approval is subject to following conditions:
  - a) The approval shall be valid for export of electricity by NVVN Ltd. to BPDB as per the period indicated in the Lol.

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- b) The approval shall not mean availability of cross border corridor for scheduling of power to neighbouring countries.
- c) The Participating Entity shall submit a copy of RPA within 15 days of signing.
- d) The cross border transaction of electricity by NVVN shall be governed by the relevant Regulations framed by Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (CERC) of India.
- e) The approval will be subject to complying with applicable sections of the Electricity Act 2003, Regulations made thereunder and any other applicable laws, rules, regulations, policies and guidelines of Government of India.
- f) The Designated Authority shall, in any form, not be made party to any loss, damage, disputes or problems arising out with respect to an entity approved by the Designated Authority for carrying out cross-border trade in electricity, for and against any claim, demand, liability, action, proceedings, cost or expense in favour of participating entities or any other third entity.
