**विषय: विद्युत के आयात/निर्यात (क्रॉस बॉर्डर) के लिए दिशानिर्देशों 2018 के तहत पावर एक्सचेंज के माध्यम से भूटान को 1250 मेगावाट बिजली के निर्यात के लिए नामित प्राधिकारी के अनुमोदन के सम्बन्ध में**

**Sub: Approval of Designated Authority for export of 1250 MW of power to Bhutan through Power Exchange(s) under Guidelines for Import/Export (cross border) of electricity 2018 -reg.**

महोदय/Sir,

This has reference to PTC India Limited (PTCIL) application dated 02.09.2025 seeking approval of Designated Authority (DA) for export of upto 1250 MW of power to Druk Green Power Corporation Limited, Bhutan from Indian Power Exchange(s) – {Both Day Ahead Market (DAM) and Real Time Market (RTM)} for a period from 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2025 to 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2026.

1. The matter has been examined in accordance with the Guidelines for Import/Export (Cross Border) of Electricity- 2018 and Procedure for Approval and facilitating Import/Export (Cross Border) of Electricity. Based on the concurrence from the Government, approval of Designated Authority is hereby conveyed to PTCIL for export of upto 1250 MW of Power to Druk Green Power Corporation Limited, Bhutan (Export from India to Bhutan) through Indian Power Exchange(s)- {Both Day Ahead Market (DAM) and Real Time Market (RTM)} for a period from 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2025 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025.
2. The proposal for export of power from January'2026 onwards will be reviewed in the month of December 2025.
3. This approval is subject to the following conditions:
  - (a) The approval shall not be clubbed with other transactions while bidding/scheduling etc.

- (b) Govt. of India reserves the right to import/ export electricity from/ to neighboring countries for reason of larger policy interest, and same shall be binding on the participating entity.
- (c) PTC and other participating entities, involved in this transaction, shall comply with the applicable Rules/Guidelines/Regulations/Standards of Government of India/CEA/CERC. The grant of approval by the Designated Authority for participation in Import/Export (Cross Border) of Electricity shall not entitle PTC any rights or extra privileges over and above the applicable laws.
- (d) As the Import of Power by Bhutan will be governed by Guidelines-2018, all the relevant Regulations/Procedures including DSM regulations of CERC shall be applicable during the period of transaction.
- (e) Scheduling, metering, settlement of charges etc. shall be governed by the modalities for compliance to Deviation Settlement Mechanism (DSM) between India and Bhutan agreed in the 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of India – Bhutan Joint Technical Team meeting held on 25.04.2024
