Ministry of Power (MoP) / Central Electricity Authority (CEA) has drafted **Quality Control Order (QCO) (attached at Annex-1)** containing seven (7) goods or articles, which has further been vetted by Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) in consideration with "Scheme-I of Schedule-II of the Bureau of Indian Standards (Conformity Assessment) Regulations, 2018".

Further it is mentioned that applicability of this Order will be limited to goods or articles (as specified), covered in respective Indian Standards.

S.O.------(E).- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 16 read in conjunction with section 17 and sub-section (3) of section 25 of the Bureau of Indian Standards Act, 2016 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), the Central Government being of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do in the public interest and after consulting the Bureau, hereby makes the following Order, namely:-

1. **Short title, commencement and application.** – (1) This Order may be called the Power Sector Products/Consumer goods (Quality Control) Order, 2021.

(2) Save as otherwise provided in this Order, it shall come into force after _____ from the date of publication in the official gazette.

(3) It shall apply to goods or articles specified in column (3) of Table 1, except such goods or articles manufactured domestically for export which conform to any other specification required by a foreign buyer.
2. **Conformity to standards.**- Every goods or articles specified in column (3) of Table 1 shall conform to the corresponding Indian Standard specified in column (2) of the said Table.
3. **Compulsory use of Standard Mark** - Every goods or articles specified in column (3) of Table 1 shall bear the Standard Mark under a licence from the Bureau as per Scheme-I of Schedule-II of the Bureau of Indian Standards (Conformity Assessment) Regulations, 2018.
4. **Certification and Enforcement Authority.**- The BIS shall be the certifying and enforcing authority in respect of goods or articles specified in this Order.
5. **Penalty for Contravention.** - Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Order shall be punishable under the provisions of the said Act.
6. **Effect of amendment or revision in Indian Standards.** – Any amendment or revision made by the Bureau to any of the Indian Standards specified in column (2) of Table 1 shall apply to this Order with effect from the date notified by the Bureau.
7. **Exemptions from applicability of this Order** - Any exemptions for non-applicability of the Order on specific product(s) shall be obtained from Ministry of Power (MoP).
8. **Clarification on QCO** – (1) In case of queries/clarifications related to applicability of this QCO on a particular product or implementation of this QCO or any matters connected therewith, stake holder(s) may approach to the Ministry of Power (MoP).

(2) In case of queries/clarifications related to coverage of any product under Indian Standard covered under QCO, stake holder(s) may approach to BIS.
