2. Terms of Reference of Committee are as under:

- i. Make self-assessment of CEA Regulations/ Rules/ Procedures etc. and identify the burdensome compliances.

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- ii. To obtain feedback from Industries/ other stakeholders on CEA Regulations/ Rules/ Procedures etc. and based on the feedback received, identify compliance burden to be reduced.
 - iii. Identification and reduction of burdensome compliances in 2022.
 - iv. Suggest measures to strengthen the Grievance redressal mechanism.
3. The Committee shall submit the draft report within 3(three) months and present it before the Authority for finalization of the identified burdensome compliances.
 4. The Chairman of the Committee may co-opt any other senior officers from CPSUs/industries as deemed fit for the identification of the burdensome compliances.
 5. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
