DFO Chatra South & Latehar had sent recommendation to HPC for issuance of tree cutting permission on 27.04.2022 and 28.04.2022 respectively. HPC recommended issuance of tree cutting permission in meeting held on 02.05.2022. Tree cutting permission has been received for 4 nos. of villages for Chatra South division and for 13 nos. of villages for Latehar forest division by 22.06.2022.

NOC from Jharkhand State Forest Development Corporation limited for tree cutting for 4 nos. of villages under Chatra Forest division has been received on 21.06.2022, 07.07.2022 and for 13 nos. of villages under Latehar division has been received on 02.08.2022.
